

Megatrends need raw materials



Megatrends include mobility and climate raw materials.

Megatrends often develop like avalanches in slow motion, slowly but powerfully. One megatrend is mobility. The focus here is on the connection between living, working and leisure. Sustainability, health and experience are also important. Due to the energy turnaround, climate raw materials are booming. Because electromobility, wind and solar energy will need more and more of these raw materials. Energy plants that use hydroelectric, solar or wind power need significantly more industrial raw materials than conventional plants. This includes silver, for example. Copper is also used, because as soon as electricity is involved, copper is needed.

Renewable energies will increasingly conquer the world. According to World Bank forecasts, the capacity of photovoltaic systems in Asia, Africa and Europe will increase to 8,500 gigawatts by 2050. Compared to today, this is about eleven times as much. By 2050, about 15,000 tons of silver will be consumed by the photovoltaic industry alone, with about 25,000 tons mined last year. So, looking to the future, silver investing shouldn't be a bad thing.

Silver in the projects own for example MAG Silver or Denarius Silver.

MAG Silver - <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=QIFoSOv06ls> - owns 44 percent of the Juanicipio project in Mexico. The partner is Fresnillo. The last quarter brought MAG Silver almost 300,000 ounces of silver and almost 500 ounces of gold.

Denarius Silver - <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=QVVXRhMOosl> - is working in Colombia and Spain. Diamond drilling is starting at the Lomero project in Andalusia, southern Spain.

Another megatrend is increasing connectivity. Digital infrastructures ensure networking in more and more areas of daily life. In addition to silver, copper is also in demand

here, because the reddish metal is a great conductor of electricity. Also, an electric vehicle needs about three times as much copper as a conventional vehicle.

GoldMining - <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=0IZV19BEQBk> -, for example, is involved in the economic metal copper. The company's projects are located in Peru, Colombia, Canada, Brazil and the USA. The raw materials contained are copper and gold.
